

SPECTATOR GUIDELINES

- 1. Please keep all conversations with players to words of encouragement. Advice **CANNOT** be given during the round.
- 2. Spectators **CANNOT** allow players to ride in a rented golf cart at any time during play. Any transportation between holes or on the course will be provided by tournament staff where designated.
- 3. We encourage spectators to walk one shot ahead of the group they are following. This procedure allows spectators to follow errant shots and help identify where a ball comes to rest. Spectators **ARE** allowed to help search for lost balls.
- 4. The KGF allows spectator carts at the discretion of the host club and will be distributed at the discretion of the host facility's policies and pricing. Spectator carts **MUST REMAIN ON THE CART PATH AT ALL TIMES**. If you are assisting with the search for a ball, leave the cart on the path and walk to the search area.
- 5. Spectators (walking or riding) **MUST** remain on cart paths. In the absence of cart paths, we ask that spectators stay in the rough. Prohibited areas include tees, fairways, hazards, bunkers, greens, scoring and starting areas. Spectators **CANNOT** walk beside a junior golfer and talk.
- 6. Spectators **CANNOT** give rulings. Please seek a KGF rules official or call the Tournament Director at (504) 400-8013 if the need arises.
- 7. Spectators **ARE** allowed to carry medicine, drinks, food, umbrellas, etc.
- 8. Spectators **ARE** allowed to use cell phones while on the golf course, but are asked to adhere to proper golf course etiquette and for ring tones to be placed on silent.
- 9. The KGF staff may assess a penalty based on the severity of a spectator violation. If a serious breach has occurred, the spectator may be asked to leave the facility or may not be permitted to attend future KGF events.
- 10. Spectators attend KGF events at their own risk. When dangerous weather approaches, the KGF will suspend play by sounding air horns. Accordingly, you should seek shelter immediately. The KGF staff will evacuate players from the course first, then spectators.
- 11. In the case of inclement weather and a course evacuation, spectator carts can be used to shuttle golfers to safety. AT NO TIME SHOULD ANYONE BE ALLOWED TO STAND ON THE BACK OR SIDES OF THE CART. All riders must be properly seated in the cart at all times.
